WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR OUR MASTER OF EDUCATION PROGRAM? (A bachelor's degree is pre-requisite.)

- Certified teachers desiring a Master's Degree in Curriculum & Instruction.
- Individuals with a bachelor's degree working with professional development or adult/continuing education.

DESCRIPTION OF OUR MASTER OF EDUCATION PROGRAM:

1. **NON-CERTIFICATION:** This master's program does not lead to teacher certification/licensure. It is designed for teachers who are already certified.
2. **NON-THESIS:** There is no mandatory culminating thesis for this program. There is instead a "capstone course" EDUC 645 Research in Instructional Design which includes an Action Research Project.
3. **ONLINE CLASSES:** All courses offered online using Sakai online management system. The 36-hour program can be completed in as little time as 16 months.
4. **TRANSFER CREDIT:** Students may transfer up to 9 credit hours to the program with permission of the director of the School of Graduate Education. Graduate transcripts may be submitted for evaluation to see if previous graduate courses taken might equate to requirements in OVU's program.
5. **BEGIN ASAP:** Students may join the program at the beginning of any semester in the sequence of courses.
6. **COURSEWORK:** Each course is 3 credit hours, and the cost is a very affordable **\$350. PER SEMESTER HOUR**. Students may enroll in 1, 2, or 3 courses each semester (fall, spring, summer). Nine credit hours will be considered a full load. Financial aid is available for students taking at least 2 classes per semester.
